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Install Java 11 on Kubuntu

```
sudo apt update
```

```
sudo apt install openjdk-11-jdk
```

```
java -version
```

Version

```
sudo update-alternatives --config java
```

Set JAVA_HOME

```
echo $JAVA_HOME
```

```
export JAVA_HOME=$(readlink -f /usr/bin/java | sed "s:/bin/java::")
```

Then, you can set the JAVA_HOME variable in your shell's configuration file (e.g., .bashrc or .zshrc). For example:

```
export JAVA_HOME=/usr/lib/jvm/java-11-openjdk-amd64
```

```
export PATH=$PATH:$JAVA_HOME/bin
```

After that, source the configuration file:

```
source ~/.bashrc # or your shell's configuration file
```
